Get more heat for your money by upgrading your heating system to a high efficiency natural gas furnace.

***Oregon Energy Tax Credit:**

Up to \$350

Requirements: Natural gas furnaces must be installed by an Oregon licensed contractor, and have a minimum 90% AFUE. Oregon Energy Tax Credit requires a furnace with an Electronically Commutated Motor (E.C.M.).

How to Participate

Step 1- Establish your eligibility.

Request a free Home Energy Review for your home, or acquire Form 300U from an Energy Trust of Oregon trade ally contractor.

Step 2- Install eligible measure.

Gas furnaces must be installed by an Oregon licensed contractor.

Step 3- Sign and submit forms.

Submit a copy of your contractor's invoice with Form 300T within **90 days** of work completion:

Incentives are effective May 1, 2006, through February 28, 2007, on a first-come, first serve basis, and are subject to change based on available funding. Special rules and restrictions may apply. Contact a trade ally or visit www.energytrust.org for details before installing your measure. Incentives cannot exceed installation cost. Home primary heat source provided by Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, NW Natural or certain other utilities. All measures must be installed by an Oregon licensed contractor, except self-install measures. Please allow six to eight weeks for incentive processing and payment.
